Cat Post Operative Notes : Surgical

Procedure:

Every patient recovers differently from an anaesthetic but we recommend that your cat is:

- **Kept inside with a litter tray fordays to ensure that the anaesthetic is totally out of their system before being let out.**
- **Fed small amounts of a bland diet like plain fish or chicken for 24 hours.**
- **Any bandages must be kept clean and dry and the patient should not be allowed outside until the dressing is removed.**
- **It is important that the patient does not lick or chew any surgical wound as this will result in infection and reduced healing. For this reason, we may send the patient home with an Elizabethan collar.**
- **Blood spotting from the wound is common and should resolve within 24 hours. Please contact the surgery if at all worried.**

After an anaesthetic it is important to note that: there may be no bowel movements for 3-4 days, but urine should be passed within 24 hours. The patient should not vomit. Hair will have been clipped for the surgical procedure and to enable venous access to administer medication and/or draw blood for sampling.

You may have been supplied medication to assist your Cat in their recovery
